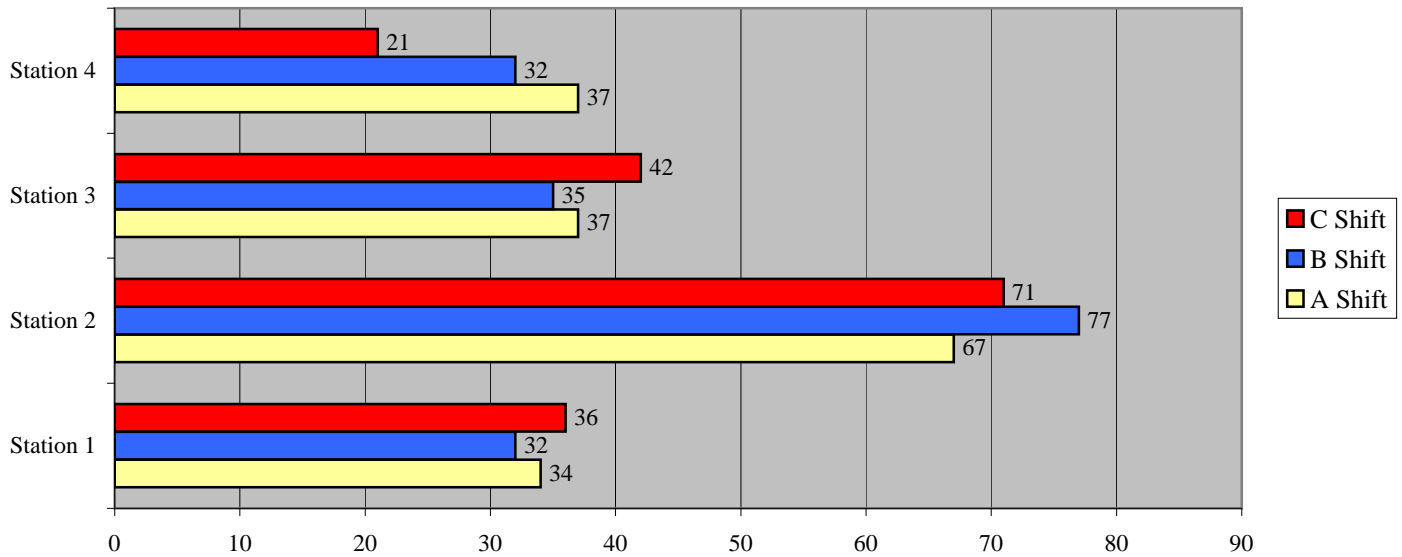

Alarm Responses (May-June 2008)

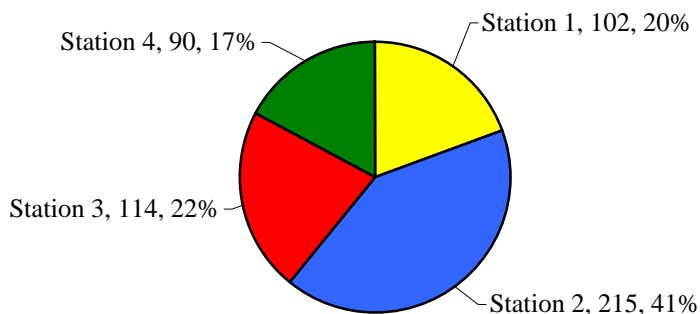
